Housing & Homelessness

Key Policies:

- Prioritise Accessible Bungalows

Expand bungalow availability not just for over-55s but also for disabled citizens and others who need stair-free living.

- Ban HMO Conversions & Student Profit Blocks

End the exploitation of communities by developers maximising short-term rent through house carving and dense student pods.

- No More Tower Blocks

Rebuild our housing landscape around low-rise homes with proper space and dignity.

- Mandatory Garden Size Minimums

Every new home must include usable outdoor space-no more token patches of grass.

- Repurpose Empty Retail Units as Temporary Shelter

Commercial units standing idle must serve those sleeping rough-no excuses.

- Retirement Home Pricing Reform

Outlaw the model of selling units at -200k+ only to reclaim and resell on death. Homes should be lived in, not flipped for profit.

- Housing for Brits First

Prioritise citizens and long-term residents in housing allocation-end mass immigration housing incentives and queue jumps.

- Housing Price Reform

Tackle unaffordable suburban prices by revaluing based on actual wages and land worth-not speculation.

- Self-Sufficiency Push

Encourage home-growing and self-reliance through incentives and community gardens-revive Dig for Victory.

- 5-Year Durability Standard for Outdoor Tools & Garden Equipment

Extend repair legislation and eliminate throwaway gardening tools.

This policy puts homes before headlines, and communities before conglomerates.

Consumer Protection

Consumer Protection

Key Policies:

- 5-Year Warranty Mandate

All appliances and garden tools must be built to last and come with a 5-year free repair guarantee.

- Free Annual Servicing

Manufacturers must provide one free service per year for the first 5 years of product life.

- Affordable Maintenance Option

After 5 years, users can opt into a -100/year maintenance plan to keep appliances running smoothly.

- Emergency Repair Response

Critical items like fridges/freezers must receive repair/inspection within 48 hours of notification.

- National Repair Network

Establish public repair hubs, training centres, and a certification scheme for independent fixers.

- 25% Buyback Scheme

Manufacturers must offer to buy back functioning units at 5 years for recycling or refurbishing.

- Ban Planned Obsolescence

Design sabotage and early expiry practices will be criminalised.

- Mandatory Labeling

Products must clearly display expected lifespan, repairability rating, and part availability.

- Ban Disposable Imports

Non-repairable or sealed-unit tech is barred from UK entry.

This policy ends throwaway culture and puts long-term value back in the hands of the public.

Energy & Infrastructure

Energy & Infrastructure

Key Policies:

- Massive Nuclear Build-Out

Restore and expand nuclear power to secure long-term domestic energy independence.

- Reopen Clean Coal via Automation

Use modern tech to safely and cleanly tap UK coal reserves while protecting health.

- Ban Solar/Wind Land Grabs

No more covering farmland with inefficient panels or wind farms-land is for food and people.

- No Foreign Energy Dependency

No more importing power or gas from the EU or hostile actors-maximise North Sea reserves.

- Ban Smart Meters

Outlaw forced smart meter installation and allow full opt-out.

- Scrap Energy Bureaucracy

Cut red tape and make energy companies directly accountable to users.

- Eliminate Standing Charges

Utilities must charge based on use only-no fees just for existing.

Energy is a right, not a racket. This policy brings energy production home-for good.

Privacy & Surveillance

Privacy & Surveillance

Key Policies:

- Ban Facial Recognition

Outlaw all facial recognition in public and private spaces.

- Ban Digital ID Schemes

No government-mandated digital tracking or ID apps. ID must never be a precondition for rights.

- Ban Smart Speaker Tracking

Alexa, Google Home, Siri-no passive data capture or sharing without physical activation.

- Ban Transaction Data Sales

Card companies may not sell your purchasing habits or personal spending profiles.

- End Forced 2FA

Make two-factor authentication optional-not mandatory.

- Consent by Default

No more pre-checked boxes. All marketing and data capture must be true opt-in.

- Right to Disconnect

No more midnight work emails. Your personal time is legally protected.

This policy restores digital freedom, human privacy, and real consent in a world addicted to data.

Justice Reform

Justice Reform

Key Policies:

- Full Sentencing

No more -10 years means 5.- Offenders serve their full sentence-no early outs.

- Death Penalty for Heinous Crimes

Reserved for the most extreme acts-final, transparent, and unshakably verified.

- Chemical Castration for Rapists

Applied immediately after conviction to prevent future harm while capital punishment is pending.

- No Luxury in Prison

No game consoles, pastel walls, or self-care cells. Prison is not a spa.

- Real Meals, Not Muck

No pre-packed or microwave junk. Fresh, nutritious meals only.

- Consensual Relationships Allowed

Inmate-inmate and inmate-officer (with zero preferential treatment) allowed if fully consensual.

- No New Identities

Offenders cannot hide behind fresh names after conviction-communities must know.

- Equal Sentencing

No gender leniency. Mothers do not get lighter treatment by default.

- 5/Day Work Stipend

Inmates doing community labour earn a flat dignity wage-not 18 cents an hour.

- Day Release for Low-Risk Emergencies

Supervised release allowed for funerals or major family events.

Justice means consequence-but it also means fairness, discipline, and zero excuses.
