?? Food & Farming Policy

Core Principle:

Food is a human right, not a corporate product. We return control to farmers, dignity to consumers, and truth to your plate.

??? Farming & Production

- Ban the use of farmland for solar farms or speculative development.
- Launch a nationwide 'Grow British' campaign.
- Natural animal diets by default.
- Raw milk and heritage methods protected and legalised.
- Return to local slaughterhouses and butchers.

? Food Access & Pricing

- Abolish the sugar tax and plastic tax.
- Introduce 'Essentials Pricing Reform'.
- Transparency in ingredients and country of origin.

? Home Growing & Self-Sufficiency

- 'Dig for Victory' revival.
- Garden space minimums in all housing developments.

- 5-year repair and support guarantee on food-growing tools.

### ? Anti-Waste & Corporate Control

- Mandatory donation of supermarket surplus food.
- Ban all advertising of ultra-processed food to children.
- Break up food monopolies.

### ?? Ethical Standards in Slaughter & Food Labelling

- Ban all non-stun slaughter, including halal and shechita, based on uncompromising animal welfare standards.
- Mandatory clear labelling on all meat and processed food:
  - Method of slaughter (stunned or non-stunned)
  - Country of origin
  - Whether any religious ritual, sacred prayer, or sanctification was performed
  - Whether the meat is halal, kosher, or otherwise ritually designated
- Ban the mixing of ritual meat with general supply.
- Freedom of worship, not forced observance.

### ?? Farm Machinery & Equipment Protections

- All agricultural machinery must come with a **\*\*minimum 10-year durability and support guarantee\*\***.
- No planned obsolescence?critical parts and software support must be available for the full 10-year term.
- Mandatory annual servicing offered at fixed, fair rates to keep machinery operational and safe.

## Food & Farming Policy

- Manufacturers must offer a **buyback or recycling scheme** at the end of the equipment's lifecycle to reduce waste.
- Farmers feed the nation?they deserve industrial-strength reliability without corporate corner-cutting.

### ? Health & Sustainability in Agriculture

#### - Ban on Harmful Pesticides & Herbicides

Immediately outlaw chemicals known or suspected to contribute to gastrointestinal conditions, coeliac disease, endocrine disruption, or neurological damage?this includes glyphosate, atrazine, and similar compounds.

#### - Mandatory Disclosure of All Agricultural Inputs

Farmers and producers must declare every chemical or treatment used in the growing, storage, or processing of food.

#### - Independent Safety Reviews, Not Corporate Lobbyists

Shift food chemical regulation to an **independent science board** with no industry ties?no more fox guarding the henhouse.

#### - Public Transparency Database

A national database listing every product?s full chemical footprint, so consumers know exactly what they?re eating.
