

Manifesto Section: Border Security & Enforcement

- One Strike Rule for Migrants

Any migrant-regardless of immigration status-who commits a criminal offence resulting in a custodial sentence will be deported upon release and permanently banned from re-entering the UK.

- No appeals, no delays.
- Applies retroactively to all convictions from 2010 onward.
- Minor infractions (e.g. parking fines) excluded-this is for violence, theft, fraud, trafficking, assault, sexual crimes, etc.

- Zero-Tolerance for Repeat Offenders

If a migrant avoids deportation after a first offence (e.g. under age or exceptional circumstance), any second arrest for any criminal charge will trigger immediate removal proceedings.

- No Refuge in Rehabilitation

Serious offences such as sexual assault, child abuse, trafficking, or terrorism cannot be avoided through "rehabilitation" claims. Protection of the British public comes first.
